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Interpreting the profile:

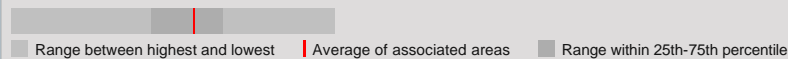
Value for this area - This is the value for the selected area. (e.g. the Local Authority, Ward etc)

Rank - This column shows where your selected area is ranked in relation to areas of the same type in Surrey. Rank 1 = highest. The figure in brackets shows how many areas are being ranked.

Surrey Average - Where † symbol is shown, this is the Surrey figure (except for the Surrey county profile where this column shows the figure for the South East region). Otherwise it is the average for areas of the same type in Surrey.

Highest/Lowest - These values show the highest/lowest figures for the areas of the same type in Surrey.

Range - The arrow ▼ indicates the position of the local value, compared to the average of the areas of the same type.
